

Clerk's Report to 28th June, 2019

Neighbourhood Warden – Contact was made regarding fly tipping on the cycle path south of Paul's Rise. The garden waste will be cleared.

Bike Trails – A tree inside the trails has a broken branch. A tree surgeon has been contacted for a quote to fell the tree.

Gloucestershire Highways – Have been contacted over several issues including removing cleared soil at Frogmarsh, a low-hanging branch on Frogmarsh Lane, overgrown hedge on the A46 between Selsley Road and Rooksmoor.

Hedge on Selsley Road – The landowner has been contacted as the hedge is now encroaching over the pavement below the junction with Southfield Road. The hedge will be cut at the beginning of August at the end of the bird nesting season.

Gulley on Convent Lane – A resident made contact to ask whether the gulley will be cleared as it has not been done recently. The resident is now aware that this will be discussed during the meeting as part of a discussion on work for Lengthsmen and the village contractor.

Parish Council Insurance – This has been renewed.

Wild Swimming – A sign for the corner of Park Lane and Convent Lane has been drafted by the National Trust. This must now gain the approval of Gloucestershire Highways and Stroud District Council Planning Department.
