Saturday 10th September 2022

Woodchester Village Show is back! Come along and enjoy this traditional event which includes the **Produce and Craft Show, Fun Dog Show**, music from **Rodborough Folk Orchestra**, refreshments, stalls and games on the church green.

We encourage as many people as possible to enter the **Produce & Craft Show** which will be held in the school hall. It really doesn't matter if you have never exhibited before, the more entries we have, the better. Children over 9 are welcome to enter any of the adult produce classes but will be judged on the same basis as adults. A full list of classes and entry forms are in this leaflet. If you have any questions, please contact Richard Butler on (01453) 872847. Each pre-booked class entry costs just 30p (adults) or 20p (children). Completed forms should be returned to the Woodchester Village Shop by 5pm on Thursday 8th September. Entries will also be accepted on the day, but the entry fee will increase to 50p a class for both adults and children.

Dog show entries will be taken on the day (50p per class). Please note dogs must be kept on a lead and under control. Sorry, but dogs are not allowed in the school hall or playground at any time.

1. VEGETABLES

- a. 3 Potatoes
- b. 3 Tomatoes (with calyx & stem)
- c. 3 Peppers or Chillies (with ~20mm stem)
- d. 3 Beetroot (leaf stalks trimmed to ~75mm)
- e. 3 Carrots (leaf stalks trimmed to ~75mm)
- f. 3 Parsnips (leaf stalks trimmed to ~75mm)
- g. 3 Onions (trimmed and necks tied)
- h. 3 Leeks (with roots and flags/leaves uncut)
- i. 3 Courgettes (max length of 150mm)
- j. 3 Runner Beans
- k. 1 Cabbage
- l. 1 Corn on the Cob (silks attached)
- m. Most exotic Squash
- n. Heaviest Marrow
- o. Most comical vegetable
- p. Any 5 different types of vegetable in a basket (judged on quality & presentation)

2. FRUIT

- a. 3 Pears
- b. 3 Dessert Apples
- c. 3 Cooking Apples
- d. 3 Figs
- e. 6 Raspberries (with calyx & stem)
- f. 6 Blackberries (with calyx & stem)
- g. Any 5 different types of fruit in a basket (judged on quality & presentation)

Jars/bottles should be labelled with the main fruit/vegetables used & date made.

- a. Jar of single fruit Jam
- b. Jar of Jelly
- c. Jar of Marmalade
- d. Jar of Chutney
- e. Jar of Piccalilli
- f. Bottle of Fruit Cordial

4. BAKING

- a. A home baked wholemeal loaf
- b. 6 fruit scones to your own recipe
- c. A Victoria sandwich cake baked with 175g (6oz) each of sugar, butter and flour, and 3 eggs
- d. 6 pieces of fruit and nut flapjack using a vegan recipe
- e. 6 vegetable tartlets (either shortcrust or puff pastry)

5. FLOWERS

- a. Arrangement: "Jubilee Tea Party"
- b. An arrangement using garden flowers and foliage in an unusual container
- c. A miniature flower arrangement under 10cm in height
- d. Three Dahlias in a vase, any colour and type. (To be judged on appearance)
- e. A single fragrant rose
- f. A vase of garden herbs

6. PHOTOGRAPHY

Entries may be in black & white or colour and in any format or size.

- a. A Reflection
- b. Hard Work
- c. What a Laugh!

7. UNDER 5 (age at 10.09.22)

- a. A decorated pebble or stone
- b. A creature made from fruit or vegetables
- c. A picture of an animal that you have drawn or painted

8. AGE 5 - 8 (age at 10.09.22)

- a. A decorated pebble or stone
- b. A miniature garden on a plate (max20cm in diameter)
- c. A model made from recycled items

Rules

1. Entry is open to anyone with a connection to Woodchester and their families, e.g. residents, those working in the parish or attending Woodchester Endowed School, and anyone attending any of the churches, clubs, societies or other organisations in the parish.
2. Exhibits must be the sole work or creation of the exhibitor and made within the last 12 months (i.e. not a joint effort by a family or couple or entered previously).
3. Children aged 9 or over on 10.09.22 may enter any classes in the Adult categories – at the children's reduced rate - as well as in their applicable children's category.
4. Entry Forms should be returned to Woodchester Village Shop by 5pm on Thursday 8th September 2022 in order to qualify for the reduced entry fee for each indicated class of 30p for adults and 20p for children. Additional entries will be accepted on the day, but the entry fee will rise to 50p for all classes.
5. Only one entry is allowed per person per class.
6. Exhibits must be delivered to Woodchester Endowed C. of E. School between 9:30am and 11:00am on Saturday 10th September 2022 for registration and must not be named. You will be given an entry number and exhibition slips when you pay. **Doors will be closed at 11:00am for judging.**
7. Winning entries will be awarded points as follows:
1st place - 3 points, 2nd place - 2 points, 3rd place – 1 point.
8. Exhibits in Categories 1 to 5 – but not any plates/baskets/vases/cups etc. holding them - will be auctioned at the end of the Show to help cover costs unless marked with a sticker which can be requested during the registration process.
9. The organisers are not responsible for any loss/damage to property of exhibitors.
10. The decision of the judges is final.
